PATIENT ELIGIBILITY

Patient eligibility for services will be determined at the initial visit. Eligible patients must live or work in Teton County, Wyoming, not have health insurance and meet income guidelines.

Patients **must** bring the following:

- Photo ID
- Proof of residence in Teton County (eg. utility bill) **or** proof of employment in Teton County (paycheck stub **or** W2 form)
- Proof of income

If it is determined that a patient is eligible to receive health services from another program, the patient will be referred to that program in our community.

Patients who have Medicare, Medicaid, Worker's Compensation or other health insurance are not eligible for services offered by Teton Free Clinic.
